Electrical Safety

General Advices on Electric Safety

- Don't remove a plug from a power point by pulling on the cord, pull the plug instead;
- Switch off electrical items that aren't in regular use, at the plug;
- Do not use any electrical items in the bathroom unless specifically designed for the use there; in this cases avoid plugging and unplugging with wet hands;
- Do not use items with damaged cords so that the wires are exposed. Check items regularly;
- Never plug too many things into one extension cord;
- Use socket covers on sockets which are not being used;
- ➤ Never purposely "retouch" any object or surface that gave you a surprise tingle or shock. Unplug it immediately.
